1 Soft tissue management

For many years, in implantology, functional results took precedence over aesthetics results. Today, with the advancement of technologies, you can no longer dissociate one from the other. Any implant treatment should try to come to the formation of a high quality gum, with neo-papilla formation around implants.

The purpose of this presentation is to introduce all surgical techniques: shifting gingival tissue with vascularization conservation, free mucosa transplant, recovered connective graft, but also new technics based P.R.F. or P.R.P.

This is why mucogingival surgery should always be associated with bone and implant surgery.

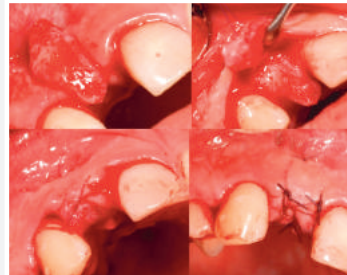
